What will you do?

- Share domestic violence and healthy relationship education in schools and community.
- Stay up to date on domestic and sexual violence prevention strategies and programs.
- Attend sexual violence prevention trainings and others for professional development.
- Organize community awareness events.
- Built relationships with community partners to increase awareness of HHAV services.
- Manage HHAV social media and online presence.
- Oversee our volunteers and provide crisis line backup (compensated).
- Manage volunteers for shelter projects as needed.
- Provide general office and phone coverage as needed.

Although most of your time will be spent developing your prevention skill and working with the community, there will be a number of opportunities to help out with tasks in the shelter. This may include support such as:

- Transportation
- Preparing a room for a new family
- Leading community meetings
- Supporting our advocates with client needs
